ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON CURRICULUM

(2022-2023)

In accordance with the feedback policy of the institution, the IQAC of the college collected feedback forms from various stakeholders, namely students and teachers. The feedbacks were collected in the online mode from the students and faculty members. The total responses received were 1325. The responses received were collected and analysed. Necessary initiatives were taken to address the issues raised by the students and teachers. More ICT based facilities were installed in the departments. New computer lab was started in the HEIS department. Purchasing of new books has been started for the library to overcome the shortage of books for the students. Teachers took extra classes and remedial classes to address the issues. Various issues regarding introduction of interdisciplinary courses and provision of sufficient courses were addressed at the beginning of the session in the orientation programme. Few departments also revised their syllabus and introduced new papers so that the students can have more choices. All the teaching departments were told to organize seminar and special lectures to enhance the learning processes and develop research attitude in the students. This would encourage a greater interdisciplinary interaction of different streams. Teacher of various department participated in the online digital training programme so that they can innovate and improvise their teaching skill. Teachers at the departmental and college level also offered various value added courses for the students to instil ethical, social and moral values in them. Students were encouraged by the teachers as well as Principal through various interactive sessions to participate in add-on courses. Various staff meetings were also organised by the Principal to address problems faced by the students and teachers. Their time to time rectification is governed by the Principal and college council members.
